

# ENIGMA

## HOUSE WINES

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1. **Malena Chardonnay/Chenin Blanc, Argentina** 13.00  
Tropical fruit and honey aromas with delicate crisp fruit flavours creating a harmonious and elegant wine.
2. **Malena Shiraz/Malbec, Argentina** 13.00  
The spicy aromas of the Shiraz blend perfectly with the intense colour and fruitiness of the Malbec to reveal a wine that is pleasing to eye, pallet and pocket.
3. **Domaine Du Tariquet Sauvignon Blanc, Cotes Du Gascoigne** 15.00  
Extremely fresh, vibrant fruit on the nose leads to a quite rich, intense palate with exceptional flavours of gooseberry laced with a hint of mandarin orange and a refreshing finish.

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## WHITE WINES

4. **Domaine Octavie Sauvignon Blanc, Touraine, Loire, France** 16.00  
Slight minerality on the nose leads to aromas of gooseberries and cut grass.  
Typical Sauvignon style with an underlying steely acidity.
5. **Chateau Mourges du Grès Les Galets Dorés, Costieres de Nimes** 16.50  
A wonderfully aromatic wine, nuances of peaches and apricots, full bodied with balanced acidity and great length. In our opinion the best white wine Francois Collard has ever made.
6. **Pikes The White Mullet 2007, Clare Valley, South Australia** 16.00  
Riesling, Viognier, Chenin Blanc & Sauvignon Blanc blend. Crisp, fresh and dry with pineapple/stonefruit flavours a little greenage with mineral acidity to give length and balance.
7. **Chablis Georges Pico, Burgundy, France** 23.00  
Typical pale lemon colour with lovely bright green glints. Very fresh with zippy citrus acidity and just a hint of mineral.
8. **Sancerre, André Dezat, Loire** 25.00  
Mouthfilling, steely and packed with gooseberries, mineral notes and zesty citrus flavours
9. **Pinot Blanc, Cave de Turckheim, Alsace, France** 17.00  
Lightly aromatic with a slight mineral edge, lively, crisp, floral fruit and a zippy finish.
10. **Bonotto Delle Teppe, Pinot Grigio, Veneto, Italy** 17.00  
Clean, crisp and dry with good mineral fruit, hints of pear, toasted almonds and light spice.
11. **William's Well Reserve Chardonnay** 16.50  
Ripe melon and fig flavours with some tangy tropical notes balanced by soft oak
12. **Forrest Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** 18.00  
Flavours of Blackcurrant leaf, elderflower, nettles, and gooseberry with a subtle mineral quality and dry and very long finish.
13. **Nimbus Single Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc, Vina Casablanca, Chile** 17.00  
Ripe, intense goosberry flavours laced with hints of cut grass and green apples.  
On the palate the wine is light to medium bodied with pleasant ripe fruit and a long finish.

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## RED WINES

14. **Pikes Red Mullet, South Australia** 18.00  
A blend of Shiraz, Grenache, Mourvedre and Tempranillo. Perfumed aromas of ripe, dark berry fruits, eastern spice and chocolate. A soft palate of sweet berries with silky smooth tannins.
15. **Vina Bujanda Rioja Crianza, Spain** 17.50  
Aromas of black fruit mingle with spicy tones gained from the oak; on the palate, the flavours replicate the aroma with the addition of vanilla and mild tobacco notes.
16. **San Lorenzo Rosso Conero, Umani Ronchi, Italy** 18.50  
Medium-bodied with sweet herb-tinged berry fruit with hints of spice and tobacco in the background.
17. **Cairanne Domaine L'Ameillaud, Côtes du Rhone Villages, France** 19.50  
Notes of blackcurrant on the nose laced with hints of raspberry. On the palate the wine is well structured with great depth and complexity.
18. **Lackey Shiraz, Killikanoon, Clare Valley, Australia** 18.00  
Full bodied with intense flavours of black cherry and plum with pepper, liquorice and a touch of acidity.
19. **Madfish Pinot Noir, Western Australia** 20.00  
Strawberry scented with great depth, complexity and power and rich gamey flavours.
20. **Finca Sopenia Reserve Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina** 18.50  
Smooth and lush with very open, sweet, perfumed aromas. Rounded flavours with sweet, pure elegant fruit.
21. **Cefiro Cabernet Sauvignon, Vina Casablanca, Chile** 15.00  
A strong bouquet of blackcurrants and a hint of mint. In the glass the wine is a classy affair with rich, ripe fruit and a brilliant rounded structure so typical of Chilean wines.
22. **Porcupine Ridge Merlot, Cape of Good Hope, South Africa** 17.00  
Mocha coffee and chocolate aromas with French oak giving some perfumed aromatics. Medium body with a lingering finish.
23. **Ailes De Paloumey 2005, 2<sup>nd</sup> Wine of Ch Paloumey, Haut Medoc** 25.00  
This wine is a 50/50 blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot; it is round and soft on the palate with delicious blackberry flavours.

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## ROSÉ

24. **Chateau Mourges du Gres Rosé, Nimes, France** 18.50  
Exuberant, fresh raspberry fruit and a clean, dry, spicy finish.

## SPARKLING

25. **Prosecco Rustico Nino Franco, Italy** 19.00  
Straw coloured and bright. Fine, persistent and crisp. Apple and pear flavours echo on the aftertaste. It is ideal for light seafood dishes and very well matched with risotto.

26. **Champagne Louis Roederer Brut Premier N.V** 45.00  
Rich, ripe and voluptuous with succulent but not quite bone dry fruit balanced by thrilling, racy acidity.

27. **Cloudy Bay Pelorus Blancs de Blancs, Pelorus, Marlborough, New Zealand** 24.00  
Fresh, lemon-like characters with savoury bready flavours mingle with luscious creamy nuances to enhance a complex palate with a crisp, clean and long finish.

28. **Bouvet Saphir Brut, Loire, France** 6.50  
"Chenin based quite exotic ripe spiced pear fruit. Very crisp and fresh, lively small bubbles and long finish." Myra Greer, Belfast Telegraph.

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## FINE & RARE WINES

28. **Chateauneuf Du Pape 2005** 55.00  
**Domaine De Vieux Telegraphe**  
"A more saturated dark ruby, it offers up notes of seaweed wrappers intermixed with truffle, black raspberry, cherry, and some black currant, pepper, and iodine.
29. **Gevrey Chambertin Vieilles Vignes 2006** 50.00  
**Vincent Girardin**  
Ruby red, dark kirsch colour. Nose shows loads of cherry and hints of leather and earthiness.
30. **Pouilly Fuisse Les Grands Champs 2005** 40.00  
**Chateau de Beauregard**  
The aromas and flavours reveal a rich wine, slightly spicy (white pepper) with vegetal hints (herb tea, fern).
31. **Puligny Montrachet Les Enseignerres 2006** 60.00  
**Vincent Girardin**  
Very elegant grassy nose, very similar on the palate; stylish and modern wine.
